Upcoming Deadline: Submit 2017 MIPS Performance Data

It's time to submit your 2017 MIPS performance data. Key dates to remember include:

• March 16 (8 pm EST) for group reporting via the <u>CMS web</u>

<u>interface</u>

• March 31 for all other MIPS reporting, including via app.cms.gov

The <u>QPP data submission system</u> is quick and easy, especially if your using certified EHR or submitting data from a registry. Once started, your data can be updated as many times as necessary up through the March 31 deadline.

Each time you update your submission, you will notice how your preliminary score changes for both each individual measure and overall score. Starting your data submission today will give you a chance to see what adjustments you may need to make before the March 31 deadline.

If data is submitted on your behalf . . .

either by an EHR vendor, Qualified Registry, or Qualified Clinical Data Registry, you can still view your submitted data by logging-in to the QPP data submission system.

Logging-In to the QPP Data Submission System

<u>To log-in and submit data</u> to the QPP website, you must have valid EIDM credentials:

- The EIDM account provides user identification for accessing CMS' systems.
- The system will connect each user with their practice Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN). Once connected, ECs can report as a group or as individual clinicians within the practice.

CMS is seeking MIPS-eligible clinicians to volunteer for a study of the new QPP data submission system. The study will use clinician feedback to improve the data submission experience, and identify additional methods for reducing burden.

How It Works: Candidates will document their experience and time spent via an online diary.

- Prior to participation, candidates will undergo a pre-study interview that helps CMS learn more about your background.
 - The interview is a one-time occurrence, and will include additional details about the online diary and overall study.
- Following the interview, candidates will receive a unique link to the online diary.
 - A typical diary entry takes an estimated 10-15 minutes.
 - Candidates can submit multiple entries until the submission period deadline on March 31.
 - When the submission period closes, CMS will lock the online diary, and may follow-up with candidates for a post-study interview.
- Selected candidates will be notified by CMS within 3 business days.
